His primary research activities focus on the socio-psychological dimensions of sport event tourism and decision-making processes of sport participants and spectators. Besides his work at Southern Mississippi, he has taught courses at

Mississippi State University and two institutions in South Korea.

Faculty Members Prominent at Summer Conferences

Sport management faculty members were active over the summer, presenting research at two major conferences. All five full-time faculty members (Jeff Noble, Mark Vermillion, Mike Ross, Wonyoung Kim and Clay Stoldt) developed or co-developed presentations at the North American Society for Sport Management Conference May 22-26 in Seattle. On the whole, the WSU sport management faculty members led or were involved in seven presentations at the event, which is the preeminent international academic conference in the field.

Dr. Stoldt also led a presentation at the College Sports Information Directors of America Convention June 22-26 in St. Louis. The presentation also involved three practitioners, who shared insights regarding the research being presented.
