

Graduate Staff Assistantship in Trombone

Description:

Assistantship requires an approximate load of 16 hours per week. Duties include:

- 1. Performance participation and *enrollment in the WSU Symphony Orchestra and the WSU Symphonic Wind Ensemble. Possible enrollment in Concert Band could be included.
 - * Enrollment can be for credit or no credit depending on specific degree requirements.
- 2. Assisting the Trombone Professor with clerical work and recruitment activities
- 3. Assisting the Trombone Professor and the Area director of W/P with other duties as assigned
- 4. Graduate assistant will study with the professor of trombone at WSU
