2+2 Articulation Agreement between

Wichita State University and Butler Community College

March 27, 2019

The purpose of this 2+2 agreement is to provide Butler Community College students the opportunity to transfer from Butler Community College to Wichita State University (WSU) in pursuit of a baccalaureate degree in Science.

This agreement is for Butler students who have:

- Earned an Associate of Arts (A.A. or Associates of Arts (A.A.))
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Applied for admission to WSU

Butler students who:

- Be guaranteed admission to WSU with completion of application and receipt of transcripts
- Enter with junior status to WSU
- Be guaranteed to transfer all credits (100 level and higher) up to a total exceeding 64 credits from Butler to WSU

Students can inquire about academic and participation requirements and financial grants by contacting the WSU Financial Aid Office (316) 941-2222.


For credit transfer from WSU to Butler, students who hold a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science will need to fulfill transfer coursework from Butler along with all WSU requirements and core requirements, and must meet all requirements for graduation as outlined by WSU.

Students transferring to WSU from Butler must meet the necessary requirements for admission to WSU and will have their transfer evaluated on an individual basis.
